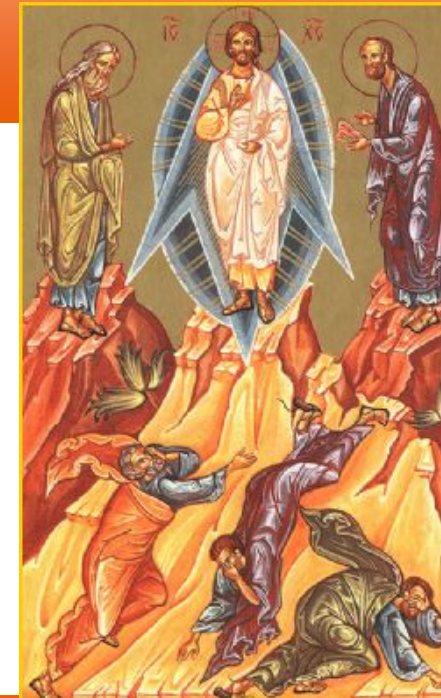

IITH SUNDAY OF MATTHEW

HOLY SCRIPTURE READING

EPISTLE – I CORINTHIANS 9: 2 - 12

GOSPEL – ST. MATTHEW 18: 23 - 25

If I am not an apostle to others, yet at least I am to you; for ye are the seal of mine apostleship in the Lord. My defense to those who examine me is this: We do not have authority to eat and to drink, do we? We do not have authority to lead about a wife who is a sister in the Lord, as also the rest of the apostles, and the brethren of the Lord, and Kephias, do we? Or do only I and Barnabas have no authority not to be working? Who at any time serveth as a soldier at his own pay? Who planteth a vineyard, and eateth not of its fruit? Or who shepherdeth a flock, and eateth not of the milk of the flock? I am not saying these things after the manner of man, am I? Or saith not the law these things also? For in the law of Moses it hath been written: "Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth the corn." It is not the care of the oxen that matters with God, is it? Or saith He it altogether for our sakes? For our sakes it was written, that the one who ploweth ought to plow in hope, and the one who thresheth in hope ought to partake of his hope. If we did sow to you spiritual things, is it a great thing if we shall reap of your carnal things? If others partake of this authority over you, should not rather we? Nevertheless we did not use this authority; but we bear up against all things, lest we should give any hindrance to the Gospel of Christ.

The Lord said this parable: "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his servants. When he began the reckoning, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents; and as he could not pay, his lord ordered him to be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and payment to be made. So the servant fell on his knees, imploring him, 'Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay you everything.' And out of pity for him the lord of that servant released him and forgave him the debt. But that same servant, as he went out, came upon one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii; and seizing him by the throat he said, 'Pay what you owe.' So his fellow servant fell down and besought him, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you.' He refused and went and put him in prison till he should pay the debt. When his fellow servants saw what had taken place, they were greatly distressed, and they went and reported to their lord all that had taken place. Then his lord summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you besought me; and should not you have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you?' And in anger his lord delivered him to the jailors, till he should pay all his debt. So also my heavenly Father will do to everyone of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart."
